Our Research

CLIMATE CHANGE

According to the WMO State of the Climate 2024/2025 assessments, there is a "Red Alert" on climate change, with 2015–2025 being the warmest decade on record due to record amounts of greenhouse gases. Ocean warming and ice loss have accelerated due to rising global temperatures, with 2024 being particularly warm. To prevent serious harm to the environment and economy, immediate action is required.

Key Reports to Reference:

Global Temperatures: The last ten years (2015–2024) have seen the ten warmest years. Roughly above pre-industrial levels, 2025 was one of the top three hottest years.

Warming Rate: Compared to 1850, the rate of warming has increased by more than three times since 1982.

Ocean Heating & Ice Loss: The ocean's heat content keeps setting new records while absorbing enormous amounts of CO₂. Sea levels are rising and glaciers are melting more quickly.

Energy Balance: The Earth's energy imbalance is a crucial indicator that the world is getting darker, lowering its surface and absorbing more solar radiation.

CLIMATE CHANGE

Extreme weather, ecosystem devastation, and significant socioeconomic disruption are all caused by climate change, which represents an unprecedented global dilemma.

Increased droughts, floods, and sea level rise are major issues that intensify food and water insecurity, destroy infrastructure, and endanger human health through illnesses and heatwaves.

As a "threat multiplier," these effects amplify already-existing social, economic, and political vulnerabilities around the planet.

Our student at the University of Waterloo, Hafsa Khan has conducted research to demonstrate the effects of climate change under "2025 Climate Change Report" located in the section Research Hub of Liliane and Roland Foundation webpage.
